If you need medical advice or treatment, please visit our website for non-urgent advice, to use e-consult or to book an appointment (These are available to book online).

Appointments are being delivered face-to-face, by telephone, or using video calls – the practice team will assess what is most appropriate for you and if you have a preference, you can discuss this with them.

Our Appointment System allows patients to pre-book up to 4 weeks in advance

When booking an appointment to see a clinician it is the practice policy that receptionists ask a reason for the appointment. This has come directly from the GP's and there are several reasons why this is important.

- If receptionists have an idea of what you are coming to the Practice for, they can ensure that you are booked with the appropriate clinician.
- It can save the clinicians time during your consultation as they can have a clear idea before your appointment what you are attending for.
- Depending on the reason given you may need to see the GP sooner, this can be facilitated by giving the reception staff as much information as you can.
- Please do not attend the practice if you are concerned you may have covid-19 symptoms. This could put both our practice team and other vulnerable patients at greater risk

Training / Protected Time Events – 2022

Face Covering rules

The legal requirement to wear a face covering no longer applies. However,

Face coverings and face masks will continue to be required in health and care settings to comply with <u>infection prevention and control (IPC)</u> and <u>adult social care</u> guidance. This includes hospitals and primary or community care settings, such as GP surgeries. They must

also be worn by everyone accessing or visiting care homes. You are required to wear a face covering on entering these healthcare settings and must keep it on until you leave unless you are exempt or have a reasonable excuse for removing it.
